- 3. To curb the vice of sexual tourism, rehabilitate and teach alternative means of livelihood to young girls and boys affected, especially in the coastal strip.*

How we do it

For sexual tourism we are currently setting up a center called "Ladies Corner" in Watamu where we will offer a listening ear, guidance & counseling. Eventually we will teach and help the affected to find an alternative livelihood.
